Children have the right to express their views. The EU wants to hear from children and to take their views into account in important decisions.

In 2021, the European Union agreed a new plan on children's rights. One main goal of the plan is to make sure children, across Europe, are heard and taken seriously. The Children's Participation Platform, set up by the European Commission in 2022, is part of that plan.

The Platform is a safe space for children to have their say and share their thoughts and ideas on European laws and policies.
