


Children of the Platform have called for action!

- EU consultation deadline early September: How do we reverse the
 decline of wild pollinating insects? Please note that an EU login is required
 to contribute, so adult support will be required to submit children's
 opinions and suggestions. Young Citizens Assembly on Pollinators
- **EU Citizen's Initiatives**: Add your support to the citizen's initiatives that matter to you. If your country allows voting at 16 or 17, then you can participate. If an initiative gets a million votes, the Commission will look at what action to take. See the open initiatives
- EU funding calls deadline 16 September:
 - Strengthening civic and democratic participation and support for common European values (addresses children)
 - Impacts of culture and the arts on health and well-being (has a specific priority for children)
 - Improving mental health outcomes for people in education, training and work (addresses children)
- EU audiobook: Dive into an enchanting and accessible tale, which doubles
 as an analogy for the story of the European Union. For children up to 12
